

## **Chain Link 2003: Post Conference Workshop**

### **Art to Wear – Turn Your Scrumbles into Wearable Art 12 Hour Workshop – Monday & Tuesday – AM & PM**

**MP28/29AP.** *Prudence Mapstone.* If you have already experimented with freeform crochet, or if you wish that your ufo's were more like masterpieces, join this two day post-conference workshop to learn how you can turn your fiber “doodlings” into wearable works of art.

**Day and Time:** 12 hours. Monday and Tuesday, July 28-29, 9:00 AM to Noon and 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Lunch on your own.

**Skills required:** No prior skills required, although the more examples of freeform experiments or textile swatches brought to this class, the closer a student will be to achieving their own individual art garment.

**Homework:** Please bring along any freeform experiments and swatches that you have previously made, if possible, or start experimenting now with any new stitch patterns you can find, creating many small (approx. 4" or less) sample pieces using a variety of yarns in colors that you feel would go well together.

**Bring to Class:** Any areas of textile work that you may have previously made (samples, swatches, ufo's), a wide assortment of yarns (any thickness) and crochet hooks, a pair of scissors, safety pins (20+), a blunt ended wool needle, a roll of brown paper (or similar for cutting a pattern) and a tape.
